

Following rebates are provided to HT Industrial Consumers of Madhya Pradesh pertaining to Electricity

- a. **Incremental Rebate for existing consumers:** A rebate of Rs. 1 per Unit in energy charges is applicable for incremental monthly consumption w.r.t corresponding month of FY 2015-16.
- b. **Rebate for new HT connections:** A rebate of Rs 1 per Unit or 20% whichever would be less, is applicable in energy charges for new connection for the consumption recorded.
- c. **Rebate for Captive power plant consumers:** A rebate of Rs 2 per unit shall be applicable on incremental units of the consumer subject to reduction in captive generation. The rebate is applicable to consumers who are switching their consumption to the licensee from their existing captive power plant.
- d. **Rebate for Open Access Consumers:** A rebate of Rs 1 per unit shall be applicable on incremental units of the consumer subject to reduction in open access consumption. The rebate is applicable to consumers who have been availing the OA during the last financial year and would be availing supply from the Licensee instead of through Open Access.
- e. **Conversion of Existing LT Industrial/Non domestic connection to corresponding HT connection:** A rebate of Rs. 1 per unit in the energy charges on the HT tariff shall be provided to those existing LT consumers who convert to HV 3 category.
- f. **Incentive for advance payment:** Advance payment made before commencement of consumption period for which bill is prepared, an incentive at one twelfth of annual interest rate in percentage applicable(12%) on working capital shall be given on the amount (excluding security deposit), which remains with the Distribution Licensee at the end of billing month.
- g. **Rebate for online payment:** Rebate of 0.5% on the total bill amount, maximum up to Rs 1000 will be applicable for making online payment of bill.
- h. **Prompt payment incentive:**

An incentive for prompt payment @0.25% of bill amount (excluding, security deposit, meter rent and Government levies viz. Electricity Duty and Cess) shall be given in case the payment is made at least 7 days in advance of the due date of payment where the current month billing amount is equal to or greater than Rs. One Lakh.
- i. **EVs: Electric Vehicles Charging Stations** are billed at Single Part Tariff and at the average cost of supply only. A rebate of 20% on the tariff is given for consumption during the solar hours.
- j. **No Metering Equipment rent/charges**
- k. **Green Energy Tariff:-** Consumers can avail green energy from the Discoms by paying additional Rs 0.56 /Kwh above the tariff. The Green Energy may be availed for any percentage of consumption and for any number of days as requisitioned by the consumer.
- l. **Other Miscellaneous rebates:-**
 1. **Time of Day (ToD) Rebate** – 20% rebate on energy charge on consumption during solar hours (9AM to 5PM) and 10% during Off peak hours (10 PM to 6 AM next day),
 2. **Rebate for supply through feeders feeding supply to predominantly rural areas:** HT consumers of this category receiving supply through rural feeders shall be entitled to 5 % rebate on Fixed Charges and 20 % reduction in Minimum Consumption (kWh) as specified above for respective voltage levels.
